



defender's office and that he desired either to "plead out", or the opportunity to "fight the case". **(EXHIBIT C)**

5. On April 18, 2007, Defendant Jason Parrish pled guilty to Promoting Contraband 2<sup>nd</sup> degree and was sentenced to a ninety day jail sentence to be served concurrent with a separate felony offense.

6. On August 1, 2007 the Oldham District Court entered an Order of Destruction providing for the destruction of *two* cellular phones that were confiscated as evidence in the herein case. On the basis of information and belief, the second cellular phone was given to Jason Parrish by an inmate work-release supervisor and co-defendant, Keli Quinn. **(EXHIBIT D)**

7. During my prosecution of the two co-defendants, I was approached by Stuart Ulferts regarding the cases. He stated to me in the courthouse hallway that it was not right for the county attorney's office to be prosecuting Keli Quinn, and that if I knew the "whole story" I would not be prosecuting her. To my knowledge, the only other witness to this conversation may have been the investigating officer, Ted Spegal, who is now a detective with the Jeffersontown Police Department.

8. Mr. Ulferts' attempt to influence my prosecutorial discretion did not impact my decision regarding the cases. Upon review of the evidence and consultation with the investigating officer, both defendants were prosecuted to the extent I deemed justifiable. At the time of their prosecution, I was not aware that Stuart Ulferts knew Keli Quinn and I do not recall any further communication with Mr. Ulferts that would have affected the outcome of this matter.

9. On June 14, 2010, an email was sent from Keli Quinn's former husband, Chris Quinn, to my father, John Fendley, the Oldham County Attorney before his death on June 28, 2010 which explains that Keli Quinn and Stuart Ulferts were having an affair in 2007. The correspondence, entitled "apology several years overdue," contains no other information pertinent to the prosecution of the case against Defendant Jason Parrish. My father and I were equally surprised by the contents of this email. **(EXHIBIT E)**

10. In August 2010, I received an unsolicited telephone call from Chris Quinn who provided more extensive information about the relationship of Keli Quinn with Stuart Ulferts, which, much to my concern indicates that Mr. Ulferts' statements to me at the courthouse were made when he was having a sexual relationship with her. Further, Mr. Quinn stated to me his knowledge that Stuart Ulferts was providing legal advice to his former wife in the criminal case against her during its prosecution.

11. Upon further inquiry, I have determined that although Jason Parrish has completed the sentence imposed by the Court, he remains imprisoned on subsequent felony charges and will be eligible for parole in November 2010.


12. The investigating officer in the subsequent felony case (08-CR-00079) was also Oldham County Detective Ted Spegal. I do not know whether Detective Spegal was aware of the affair between Stuart Ulferts and Keli Quinn when he charged Jason Parrish, nor do I know whether Stuart Ulferts had any direct communication with Detective Spegal regarding Jason Parrish or Keli Quinn, either before or after the herein case was resolved. Moreover, I do not know the effect, if any, that Jason Parrish's conviction on the Promoting Contraband 2<sup>nd</sup> degree charge will have on the likelihood of his parole on the other charges being served.

13. I do not believe Defendant Jason Parrish is entitled to relief from judgment in the herein case under CR 60.02 insomuch that the conflict of interest, as outlined *supra*, was unknown to the Commonwealth during the prosecution of the case. However, because Keli Quinn was a material witness (and co-defendant) to Defendant Jason Parrish, I submitted a request to the Kentucky Bar Association Ethics Committee regarding the Commonwealth's obligation to disclose the newly discovered evidence about Stuart Ulferts' apparent, inappropriate relationship with her. The herein declaration to the Court is made pursuant to their lettered response on September 30, 2010, stating that duties of candor, fairness and diligence necessitate disclosure to Defendant Jason Parrish.

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is agreed to this 28 day of August, 2006 by and between JOHN R. FENDLEY, Oldham County Attorney, and STUART ULFERTS, Attorney at Law pursuant to Stuart Ulferts becoming an employee of Oldham County, Kentucky as an Assistant County Attorney.

The parties agree and understand that the terms of service will be as follows:

1. Stuart Ulferts will be paid a salary of \$48,000.00 per year.
2. Stuart Ulferts will be reimbursed for his office expenses at a fixed rate of \$1,000 per month. Said reimbursement shall be paid by the County Attorney's office until January 1, 2006. The next payment, if any, shall be subject to re-negotiation between the parties, according to need, and to the willingness of Fiscal Court to assume the obligation.
3. Stuart Ulferts shall receive a letter of coverage from the Oldham County insurance carrier acknowledging that they would be responsible for Stuart Ulferts as Assistant County Attorney.
4. As a Civil Assistant County Attorney, Stuart Ulferts will be required to:
  - a. Provide legal service to the Planning and Zoning Commission, to include attending hearings and meetings of the Planning and Zoning, Board of Adjustments, and Code Enforcement Board.
  - b. Attend meetings and discuss issues with the chairs listed above in paragraph a.
  - c. Be familiar with Oldham County Bylaws, Comprehensive Plan.

Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations, KRS Chapter 100, and the 2005 Annual Report.

d. In concert with the Oldham County Attorney, John R. Fendley, help prepare any filings concerning suits brought by the Planning and Zoning Commission,

Board of Adjustments or Code Enforcement Board against any entity in Oldham County


e. In concert with the Oldham County Attorney, John R. Fendley, respond to lawsuits against any of the three agencies listed above in paragraph d.

f. Be available for consultation with the various committees of Oldham Fiscal Court if needed and to help committees formulate recommendations to Fiscal Court or formulate proposed ordinances to be considered by Fiscal Court.


g. Be available to attend Fiscal Court meeting if the County Attorney is unavailable to attend.

5. The total time to be dedicated to public business shall be no more than 32 hours per week.

6. This is the entire agreement between the parties and no changes shall be made herein unless the same are in writing and signed by the party against whom modification is to be enforced.



Apology several years overdue

Mr. Fendley:

My name is Chris Quinn. I live Heather Hills in Buckner. I used to be married to Keli Quinn, now known as Keli McCullough Ulferts. She's married to your opponent in the upcoming election. In fact married him 3 months after our divorce was final (divorce final March of 2008, marriage in June, 2008).

When you brought charges against Keli in January, 2007 for a sexual relationship she had with an inmate from the Oldham County Jail I thought you were being overly aggressive, and I was angry about that. I know many in the community shared my sense of disbelief, as was evidenced by the stack of letters she got after charges were publicized, from people who often bad-mouthed you and expressed confidence that the charges were made up and would crumble under further scrutiny. For my anger, and whatever ill words I spoke about you, I am sorry.

In July, 2007 when Keli was 4 months pregnant with our fourth child, I discovered she was having an affair with Mr. Ulferts. I uncovered the affair with Mr. Ulferts and confronted Keli with the information. At that time she said she was trying to get money back to Mr. Ulferts for the apartment he had rented for her, and was trying to break the affair off. I suggested that she go stay in the apartment Mr. Ulferts rented for her.

I want you to know that I admire your integrity and courage in taking the course of action you did. It must not have been easy to have been the one who appeared to have a vendetta against the darling of main street. Turns out you were right, that you had a better understanding of her than I did. Of course, all I had was her version of events, but even that became worse as time went on.

I also want you to know that as much as the events of 2007 revealed the character of Keli, they also revealed the character - or lack thereof - of your opponent. Nothing would make me happier than to see him resoundingly defeated in November.
